ROAD COURTESY
CERTIFICATES

MILESTONES

Ralliers achieve milestones as they attend an increasing number of rallies and for doing so they receive special discs:

National rallies – after attending 10, 25, 50, 75, 100, 125 etc rallies

Regional rallies – after attending 15, 30, 60, 90, etc rallies

FULL HOUSE

The Full House award goes to members who attend all rallies (normally 12) arranged by Natal Highway Region during the caravan year commencing with the August rally and ending with the following July rally. Only two Highway families have achieved this at least 10 times and they are Mike & Karen Grove-Mitchell and Jan & Joy Störm.

AMPER DAAR

Those who fail by one rally to achieve a Full House are nevertheless awarded for trying and qualify for the Amper Daar award. Both awards are in the form of a special disc.

PRESIDENT'S AWARD

For every 5 new members signed on as members of CCSA the introducer is presented with a President's Award.

The Annual General Meeting is held in August each year and just before this members are asked to submit the name/s of member/s who they consider to be worthy recipients of the Regional Caravaner of the Year award. The guidelines for this award are as follows:

R – **Regular** attendance at rallies and Club events.

V – **Volunteers** to do marshal duties, and helps out wherever needed when asked to do so.

N – **Neatness** of car, caravan and site.

E – Sets a good **Example**.

R – Promotes the Club and the **Region** at every opportunity.
